Sunday's Readings...

St John draws back the curtain between heaven

Ocurtain between heaven and earth to provide us with a vivid description of the

great heavenly company of saints praising God, in the new and heavenly Jerusalem "from every nation, race, tribe and language". This is the company that we are all called to join, and as people loved by God enough to call us his own children, the company that God wants us to join! So how do we do it? Jesus, in the famous Gospel passage that is known as the Beatitudes, gives us a description of the qualities of people who are indeed saints. We need to be poor in spirit, to hunger for what is right, to be merciful, pure and makers of peace. And last of all, we may even need to suffer just because we are Christians. The name "beatitudes" comes from the Latin "Beatus" which means blessed and happy. It will not be possible to be

more blessed or more happy than in the company of God in His heavenly glory. God intended us to be happy with Him for all eternity. May men and women everywhere live lives that start making that true happiness happen today.
