This may include exceptional musical skills, a doctor's surgical expertise or the craftsmanship of the accomplished bricklayer. But Jesus also means to include our abilities to be good parents, or faithful friends, to comfort the sad or raise money for the needy. Too often, we can feel inadequate about our own skills in the face of others, or powerless to help world problems. But whatever we can do, Jesus calls us to do it to serve Him and our neighbour. Not to use our talents that could help others is not

simply a waste but a failure to love and therefore a sin. Nervousness and modesty are no excuses for not loving!


