



## Sunday's Readings...

**T**he perfect wife that the Book of Proverbs describes is not a woman who is simply beautiful and good at housework. She is a woman

of real depth and strength of character blessed with wisdom and love, whose great talents are at used to help her family and her fellow human beings. talents that Jesus refers to in the Gospel parable this week, are our gifts and abilities in the broadest sense. This may include exceptional musical skills, a doctor's surgical expertise or the craftsmanship of the accomplished bricklayer. But Jesus also means to include our abilities to be good parents, or faithful friends, to comfort the sad or raise money for the needy. Too often, we can feel inadequate about our own skills in the face of others, or powerless to help world problems. But whatever we can do, Jesus calls us to do it to serve Him and our neighbour. Not to use our talents that could help others is not simply a waste but a failure to love and therefore a sin. Nervousness and modesty are no excuses for not loving!
